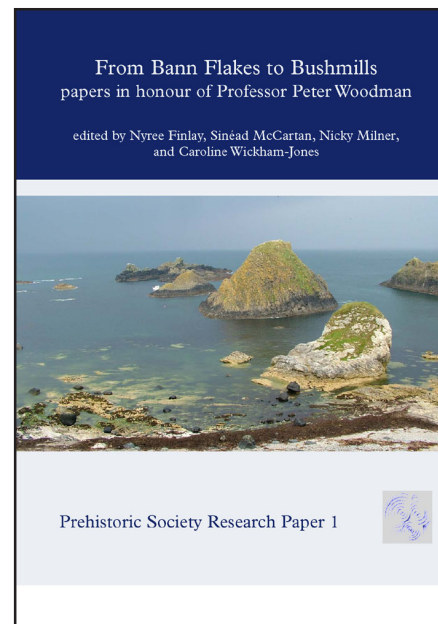

The twenty-one papers, dedicated to Peter Woodman, cover many aspects of predominantly Mesolithic archaeology in Ireland, mainland Britain and North-west Europe, reflecting the range and breadth of Peter's own interests and the international esteem in which his work is held. His particular interest in antiquarians and the material they collected began early in his career and Part 1 presents papers which deal with artefacts and finds by antiquarians. Part 2 is concerned with fieldwork projects, both new sites and sites which have been re-investigated, predominantly focusing on the Mesolithic period.
